



Bridging the Gap: Basic Training for Medical Interpreters

This course is a 40-hour professional development program that prepares bilingual individuals to work as medical interpreters. It is used to train novice and experienced medical interpreters nationally as well as internationally. The course covers:

- **Basic interpreting skills.** Roles, ethics, conduit and clarifier interpreting, managing the flow of the session
 - **Information on health care.** Introduction to health care systems, anatomy, basic medical procedures
 - **Culture in interpreting.** Self-awareness, basic characteristics of specific cultures, traditional health care in specific communities, culture brokering
 - **Communication skills for advocacy.** Listening skills, communication styles, how doctors think, appropriate advocacy
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Registration/Pre-enrollment Information and Requirements:

- **Tuition: \$700.00** (includes a \$150.00 non-refundable deposit)
- All applications are accepted on a first come first serve basis
- Receipt of completed application with the \$150 non-refundable deposit covers Language Proficiency Assessment and processing fees
- Participants must pass the Language Proficiency Assessment as part of the enrollment process
- Application must be received no later than **March 1st, 2023**

Registration Enrollment Procedure:

- Step 2:** Mail \$150 check, payable to Finger Lakes Community Health, Attention BTG, PO Box 423, Penn Yan, NY 14527
- Step 3:** Once we receive your completed application form and \$150 non-refundable deposit, we will send you instructions via email on how to proceed with the Language Proficiency Assessment.
- Step 4:** Once you've completed the Language Proficiency Assessment, you will receive an acceptance email.
- Step 5:** Confirm your attendance, and pay the balance of \$550.00 for the tuition.
