

## Bridging the Gap: Training for Mental Health Interpreters

This course is a 24-hour professional development program that prepares bilingual individuals to work as medical interpreters in the mental health care field. Proof of successful completion of the 40-hour Medical Interpreting course is required. Applicants must be 18yrs of age or older and have a minimum of a high-school diploma or equivalent. This mental health interpreting course covers:

- Terminology related to mental health.
- Challenges in mental health interpreting.
- Mental health interpreting techniques.
- Impact of culture on mental health.
- Practice interpreting skills.

## Registration/Pre-enrollment Information and Requirements:

- Tuition: \$500.00 (includes a \$150.00 non-refundable deposit)
- All applications are accepted on a first come first serve basis
- Receipt of completed application with the \$150 non-refundable deposit covers Language Proficiency Assessment and processing fees
- Participants must pass the Language Proficiency Assessment as part of the enrollment process
- Application must be received no later than 30 days prior to the first class.

## **Registration Enrollment Procedure:**

- Step 1: Complete and submit the application via email to Beverly Sirvent at beverlys@flchealth.org no later than 30 days prior to the first class. If you don't receive an email confirmation within 3 days of submitting your application, call (585) 370-2864.
- Step 2: Mail \$150 check, payable to Finger Lakes Community Health, Attention BTG, PO Box 423, Penn Yan, NY 14527
- **Step 3:** Once we receive your completed application form, the \$150 non-refundable deposit, and proof of completion of a 40-hour medical interpreter course, we will send you confirmation of enrollment via email
- **Step 4:** Confirm your attendance, and pay the balance of your tuition.

**Location:** Hybrid. First and last class will be in-person in Geneva, NY. The other classes will take place remotely.
